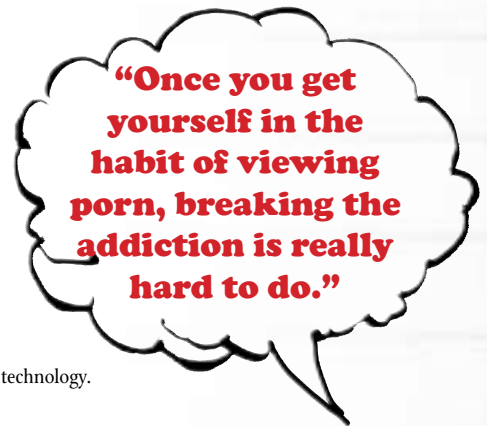


Session 6 / I See Naked People
